The Euromed Aviation Project is pleased to announce that the courses of its Training Plan are now open for registration and start as of June 2008.

There are more than 20 different courses addressing 6 aviation themes:

- Air Transport,

- Air Traffic Management,
- Overall Management

These courses will be delivered in one, two or three sessions from June 2008 to December 2009. They are free for eligible people whose expenses (air ticket & accommodation) are taken in charge by the Project.
